I am requesting funding for the Porter Post Office Drainage Improvements Project for fiscal year 2026.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Montgomery County Precinct 4, located at 23628 Roberts Road, New Caney, Texas, 77357.

These funds would be used to complete surveying, hydrologic and hydraulic analyses, environmental documentation, preliminary design, and right-of-way identification for drainage improvements adjacent to the Porter Post Office in Montgomery County, Texas.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Post Office has experienced repeated flooding due to runoff from nearby poor drainage conditions and will reduce the risk of future flood damage as well as preserving critical mail services for the Porter community.
