Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the IH-69 Southbound Frontage Road Drainage Improvements Project for fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Montgomery County Precinct 4, located at 23628 Roberts Road, New Caney, Texas, 77357.

These funds would be used to complete surveying, environmental clearance, engineering design, and right-of-way identification necessary to advance construction of drainage improvements along the IH-69 southbound frontage road between SH 99 and Bens Branch in Montgomery County, Texas. The project will support implementation of stormwater infrastructure upgrades, including storm sewer systems, roadside ditch improvements, and culvert enhancements to improve roadway drainage performance.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because recurring flooding along this corridor renders the roadway impassable during moderate and severe storm events, disrupting daily commuting, freight movement, and emergency access. Federal investment will accelerate a long-delayed infrastructure project that improves roadway safety, reduces congestion, and enhances the reliability of a major regional transportation corridor that has not been prioritized within existing state funding constraints.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133, Surface Transportation Block Grant Program.
