MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 1

Offered by M_. M . moves to recommit the bill H.R. 1 to the Committee on the Judiciary with instructions to report the same to the House forthwith with the following amendment: Add, at the end of the bill, the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly): DIVISION D—UPHOLDING 1 SUFFRAGE IN AMERICA 2 TITLE XI—UPHOLDING 3 SUFFRAGE IN AMERICA 4 SEC. 11001. SHORT TITLE. 5 6 This division may be cited as the "Upholding Suffrage in America Act" or the "USA Act". 8 SEC. 11002. FINDINGS. 9 Congress finds as follows: 10 (1) Voting is fundamental to a functioning de-11 mocracy. 12 (2) The Constitution prohibits discrimination in

voting based on race, sex, poll taxes, and age.

2	United States maintains the legitimacy of its elec-
3	tions and protects them from interference, including
4	interference from foreign threats and illegal voting.
5	(4) The city of San Francisco, California, is al-
6	lowing non-citizens, including illegal immigrants, to
7	register to vote in school board elections.
8	(5) Federal law prohibits non-citizens from vot-
9	ing in elections for Federal office.
10	SEC. 11003. SENSE OF CONGRESS.
11	It is the sense of Congress that allowing illegal immi-
12	grants the right to vote devalues the franchise and dimin-
13	ishes the voting power of United States citizens.
